Liability Insurance for Student Members

The IAAMB/ACWT is a corporate member of the ABMP, Associated Bodywork and Massage Professionals.

The ABMP/ASCP occurrence-form liability policy provides coverage for each individual student member's human and animal massage and bodywork for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage up to the below limits. These are the limits:

Rented to Premises Rented to You)..... \$100,000

ABMP student membership liability insurance is available for \$45.00 for up to 12 months while you are still in school *or* until completion of your training, whichever comes first. Membership is renewable, provided you remain in school and are not practicing for compensation.

The Student insurance does not cover you if you practice for compensation, or after you have completed your training. When you qualify for and upgrade your membership to Professional status, you may enroll in the insurance program for an additional \$150 for the first year. After the first year, you will qualify for the IAAMB/ACWT discounted Professional rate of \$175.
